



## **Two-Day Cemetery Preservation Workshop**

**Wednesday, October 5th - 6:30 PM – 8 PM (*Part 1*)**

**Saturday, October 8th - 10 a.m - 12 noon (*Site Visit*) (*Part 2*)**

New York Historic Cemetery Preservation Society (NYHCPS) will conduct a two-day workshop on abandoned cemeteries, their significance and preservation techniques.

The first workshop which will be held at the Little Falls Community/Senior Center (524 E. Main St.) will include an overview of the basics of safety when entering an abandoned cemetery, the architectural and historical value of the gravestones, preservation and maintenance, the connection to genealogy, and a brief overview of the New York state laws.

A site visit to a nearby abandoned cemetery will be conducted during the second workshop. This will provide participants “hands-on” experience to take advantage of what they have learned.

The class is open to anyone 18 years of age and older unless accompanied by a parent or an adult. Space is limited to 20 people. The cost of the two-day workshop is \$30 which includes handouts and supplies for the site visit.
